- 2. **Complete the "TTT Prerequisites" Learning Program on the eLearning Center.** (NOTE: Please allow 2 business days after registering for the TTT session to be assigned the TTT Prerequisites.) It takes approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes to complete all of the prerequisite courses.
